Travel Tip #1: Store Extra Luggage at Hotel in Cusco while Visiting Machu Picchu

Most trains have strict weight and size restrictions on luggage. This generally means only one piece of hand luggage (backpack, handbag, or briefcase) weighing no more than 5 kg/lllbs. measuring no more than 62 linear inches/157 linear cm (height + length + width). Note: requirements are subject to change so recommend confirming with specific train once booked.

Travel Tip #2: Prepare for Altitude Changes in Cusco and Machu Picchu

Be proactive and schedule an appointment with your doctor or with <u>Passport Health</u> prior to departure to obtain a prescription to Acetazolamide (Diamox) to help prevent altitude sickness in Cusco and Machu Picchu. Additionally, once you arrive in Cusco drink plenty of water and avoid large meals and alcohol.

Travel Tip #3: Leverage Hotel Concierge to Book Entry Tickets to Machu Picchu

The Sanctuary Lodge is helpful in arranging bookings and can have the tickets available upon check-in so you don't need to physically pick them up in Aguas Calientes. Book tickets early and take note of the experience you'd like (citadel, climbing Machu Picchu or Huayna Pichu Mountains, etc.). There are limited entry tickets each day and further restrictions are place effective in 2021.

Travel Tip #4: Embrace the Scenery on the Train to Machu Picchu

The journey from Cusco to Machu Picchu takes you through a breathtaking scenic route through the Andes Mountains. Book a train with panoramic windows such as the <u>PeruRail Vistadome</u> and <u>IncaRail 360°</u>, both suggested in this itinerary. For the ultimate luxury experience consider booking tickets on the <u>Hiram Bingham</u> train.

Travel Tip #5: Pack Smart for the Amazon Rainforest

Pack loose fitting clothing (lightweight long pants and long-sleeved tops) for the Amazon Rainforest. Additionally, bring a wide-brimmed hat, bathing suit, extra socks, and comfortable walking shoes. Another great tip is pretreating clothing with Permethrin mosquito repellant.
